2010.

Importance

The headwaters of the
South Fork Clearwater
River rise near Elk City, so this streamgage provides critical information about the river high in the watershed. This key location makes the Elk City streamgage a perfect addition to the [USGS National Streamflow Information Program](#). The South Fork Clearwater River is also a prized steelhead fishery, and knowledgeable fisherman keep an eye on data from this streamgage to plan their trips.
