

USGS 13057500, Grays Lake Outlet near Herman, Idaho

Location

About 3.5 miles west of Herman and 8 miles upstream of Brockman Creek in Bonneville County.

Period of Record

1916-1925 (irrigation seasons only), June 1966 to October 1970, May 2002 to present (irrigation seasons only).

Extremes for Period of Record

- Maximum discharge: 1,350 cubic feet per second, recorded on May 15, 1917.
- Minimum discharge: No flow recorded April 25, 1917.

Importance

Like many USGS streamgages in Idaho, the Grays Lake Outlet streamgage is important to managing irrigation for agriculture. Data from this streamgage are also important to managing the water resources of the nearby Grays Lake National Wildlife Refuge, home to the largest nesting population of greater sandhill cranes in the world.
