

USGS 13092747, Rock Creek at Twin Falls, Idaho

Location

About 0.2 miles south of Highway 30/93 in Twin Falls, Twin Falls County.

Period of Record

October 1992 to present.

Extremes for Period of Record

- Maximum discharge: 570 cubic feet per second, recorded May 18, 2005.
- Minimum discharge: 26 cubic feet per second, recorded April 2, 1994.

Importance

Data from USGS streamgages are used for a variety of reasons, from flood forecasting to allocation of water for irrigation, but another vital use is for assessing water quality. Since the 1950s, the [USGS National Water-Quality Assessment Program](#) has used data from the Rock Creek streamgage to monitor the quality of water in agricultural regions. The USGS and the Idaho Department of Fish and Game regularly collect fish and other aquatic biological samples at this site to monitor the health of the watershed.
